과거의 선한(virtuous) 행동을 회상하는 것은 이타주의를 촉진하지만, 타인의 반응과 같은 외부적(external) 인정에 집중하는 것은 오히려 자선적인 마음을 감소시킨다는 내용이 적절하다.

해석: 과거의 도덕적 행동을 성찰하는 것은 이타주의를 증진시키는 반면, 외부의 인정에 집중하는 것은 자선 정신을 감소시키는 경향이 있다.

40-13 보기 조합형 (객관식)

정답: ⑤ ㉠, ㉡, ㉢, ㉣가 일치하지 않음

[정답 해설]

㉠ 성인의 뇌는 공정한 행동을 유지하려는 경향이 있으므로 틀림. ㉡ 선행을 기억한 그룹이 악행 그룹보다 두 배 더 많이 기부했으므로 틀림. ㉢ 타인의 반응을 묘사한 그룹은 기부를 덜 했으므로 틀림. ㉣ 내재적 가치에 집중하는 것이 더 관대하다고 했으므로 틀림. ㉤, ㉥, ㉦는 지문 내용과 일치한다.

해석: ㉠ 성인의 뇌는 본질적으로 공정한 행동을 영속시키려는 욕구가 부족하다. (거짓) ㉡ 나쁜 행동을 기억한 집단이 착한 행동을 기억한 집단보다 더 많이 기부했다. (거짓) ㉢ 자신의 친절에 대한 타인의 반응을 묘사하는 것은 관대함의 증가로 이어졌다. (거짓) ㉣ 연구는 행위의 내재적 가치에 집중하는 것이 이타주의를 감소시킨다는 것을 발견했다. (거짓)

40-14 어법 조합형 (객관식)

정답: ① ㉠, ㉡가 어법상 틀림

[정답 해설]

㉠ double 뒤에 선행사가 없으므로 관계대명사 that이 아닌 what이 와야 한다. ㉡ 문장의 주어 자리이므로 과거 분사 preoccupied가 아닌 동명사 Being preoccupied 혹은 Preoccupation이 되어야 한다. ㉢는 부정어구 도치(Only when...), ㉣는 본동사, ㉤는 과거완료, ㉥는 It~that 강조구문으로 모두 올바르다.

해석: ㉠ 그들이 준 것의 거의 두 배... ㉡ 그들의 이미지에 사로잡혀 있는 것은 그들이 더 적게 기부하게 만들었다.

40-15 어휘 조합형 (객관식)

정답: ③ ㉠, ㉡, ㉢, ㉣가 문맥상 적절함

[정답 해설]

㉠ 선행을 나열한 사람들이 더 많이 기부했으므로 misdeeds(악행)는 적절하지 않다(benevolent actions가 적절). ㉡ 타인의 반응은 외부적인 것이므로 extrinsic은 적절해 보일 수 있으나, 지문 맥락상 '반응' 자체를 수식하기보다 '이미지'나 '외부적 보상'의 맥락에서 쓰였다. 하지만 더 명확하게 ㉢가 틀렸고, ㉠(유지하다), ㉡(도덕적인), ㉢(내재적인), ㉣(관대함)는 문맥상 매우 적절하다. ㉤는 '외부적인 반응'으로 해석 가능하나 지문의 핵심 대조군은

intrinsic vs image/reaction이다.
해석: ㉠ 유지하다 ㉡ 도덕적인 ㉢ 내재적인 ㉣ 관대함

40-16 어법 고쳐쓰기 (서술형)

모범답안: 1. invite → invited
2. tending → tended

[정답 해설]

첫 번째 오류는 수동태(be + p.p.)의 형태 오류이며, 두 번째 오류는 문장의 본동사 자리에 준동사가 쓰인 오류이다.

해석: 연구 프로젝트에서, 이전의 선행을 나열한 참가자들은 나중에 자선 단체에 기부하도록 요청받았다. 하지만 자신의 친절에 대해 사람들이 어떻게 반응했는지를 상세히 설명한 사람들은 행위에만 순수하게 집중한 사람들보다 훨씬 적게 기부하는 경향이 있었다.

40-17 본문 빈칸 완성 (서술형)

모범답안: (1) self-image (2) image

[정답 해설]

본문의 'acting in alignment with that self-image'와 'preoccupied with their image'에서 근거를 찾을 수 있다. (1)은 자신을 선한 사람으로 보는 자아상을, (2)는 타인에게 비치는 이미지를 의미한다.

해석: 성인들은 도덕적인 사람으로서의 자신의 자아상과 일치하기 때문에 착한 행동을 유지하는 경향이 있다. 하지만 사람들이 자신의 이미지와 타인이 자신의 행동을 어떻게 인식하는지에 너무 신경 쓰게 되면, 그들은 실제로 덜 관대해진다.

40-18 조건 영작 (서술형)

모범답안: It was those who prioritized the intrinsic value of performing good deeds that were more generous.

[정답 해설]

주어진 'those who prioritized the intrinsic value of performing good deeds'를 강조하는 It is ~ that 강조구문을 사용하여 영작한다. 시제가 과거이므로 It was를 사용한다.

해석: 선행을 하는 것의 내재적 가치를 우선시했던 사람들이 보다 더 관대했던 사람들이었다.

[전문 해석]

Those who prioritized the intrinsic value of performing good deeds were more generous.

40-19 주제 영작 (서술형)

모범답안: The motivation for altruism depends on internal self-perception rather than external validation.

[정답 해설]

지문의 핵심 내용인 '이타주의의 동기는 외부적 정보보다 내면의 자아 인식에 달려 있다'는 내용을 주어진 단어들을 활용하여 구성한다. depend를 주어(motivation)에 맞춰 3인칭 단수형인 depends로 변형하여 작성한다.

해석: 이타주의에 대한 동기는 외부적인 확인보다는 내면적인 자아 인식에 달려 있다.

40-20 요약 서술형 (서술형)

모범답안: (1) virtuous (2) preoccupied

[정답 해설]

지문에서 선행을 회상할 때 기부가 늘어난다는 부분의 'virtuous acts'와, 타인의 반응이나 이미지에 집착할 때 기부가 줄어든다는 부분의 'preoccupied with their image'에서 단어를 찾을 수 있다.

해석: 도덕적인 행위를 회상하는 것은 관대함을 증가시키지만, 외부의 반응에 사로잡혀 있는 것은 그것을 감소시킨다.
