정답: ③ (c) hastened → delayed

[정답 해설]

글의 흐름상 연령의 경계가 확장되고 고정관념이 약해지고 있으므로, 노년(oldness)이라는 개념은 더 늦게 찾아오는 것으로 인식되어야 한다. 따라서 '재촉하다, 앞당기다'라는 의미의 hastened는 문맥상 '지연되다, 뒤로 밀려나다'라는 의미의 delayed로 바뀌어야 적절하다.

해석: 베이비 부머 세대가 중년에 접어들면서 노년이라는 개념은 뒤로 밀려났고, 특정 연령대에서 사람들이 무엇을 해야 하거나 하지 말아야 하는지에 대한 기대치는 늘어났다.

지문은 나이에 대한 고정관념이 약해지고, 특정 나이에 해야 할 일들에 대한 경계가 모호해지거나 확장되고 있다는 내용을 담고 있다. 빈칸 뒤의 'extended or loosened(확장되거나 완화되다)'와 호응하며 글의 주제를 관통하는 표현은 '이전의 연령 경계'이다.
